Three finalists for each category will be notified and then announced on the Lions Clubs International Web site (www.lionsclubs.org). Finalists should plan to attend the awards ceremony (at their own expense) held during the 2012 Lions International Convention in Busan, Korea. International directors will accept awards on behalf of winners from their constitutional areas who are unable to attend.
